Terms and Conditions

As student you agree with the next terms and conditions to get access to Pscribe:

- A) Before being registered you have to:
- 1. complete the registration form,
- 2. agree to our privacy terms and conditions by:
 - a. reading the short info under the hyperlink terms and conditions,
 - b. clicking on "I accept the terms and conditions",
- 3. push the green button [Register],
- 4. go to your own student's emailbox and activate the confirmation link, before you go to login.
- B) While working with Pscribe the following data and information are gathered and stored:
- 1. personal information you entered on the registration form,
- 2. all data while working with Pscribe cases, by example:
 - a. the cases you have worked on,
 - b. time spent on each step in a case,
 - c. the drug-groups and medicines you have chosen,
 - d. the mc quesions you have answered.
- C) Authorized teachers and researchers have access to the stored data under the next conditions:
- 1. they have to comply with the rules of the right to privacy and data protection in:
 - a. the Netherlands; articles 33 & 34 (juncto art. 1 sub i) & 7 & 8 of the dutch law (Wbp),
 - b. the European Union (EU); primary law (Article 7 and 8 of CFR, & Article 16 of TFEU).^{1,2}
- 2. presentations and publications of all the processed data are only allowed:
 - a. under the rules mentioned here above in item C1:a,b
 - b. when data are grouped (anonymity) and could not be traced to individuals.
- D) That the legitimate and ultimate goals to collect and analyse these data are:
- 1. to make the Pscribe system & content more sophisticated,
- 2. to improve prescribing of all participants,
- 3. for healthy ageing purposes.
